There are a number of ways to give financially to Highgate International Church, detailed below.

1. By bank transfer or regular Standing Orders

These are an easy way to give and are great for us as they help with our planning. If you use internet banking you can easily make one-off payments or set up regular “Standing Order” giving yourself.

2. By Cheque

You can also give by cheque, made payable to ‘Highgate International Church.’

3. By cash in the HIC building

We have a donation box at the rear of the main hall for us when the building is open and during Sunday mornings when we meet together. If you’re a UK taxpayer and give in this way, please complete a gift aid envelope with any contribution over £30.

Boost your donation by 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate

If you are a UK taxpayer then Gift Aid can be reclaimed by the charity from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer. Please fill in a **Gift Aid form** (hard copy available by donation box in the main hall, or download from the HIC website) which enables the church to receive tax back as a registered charity.
